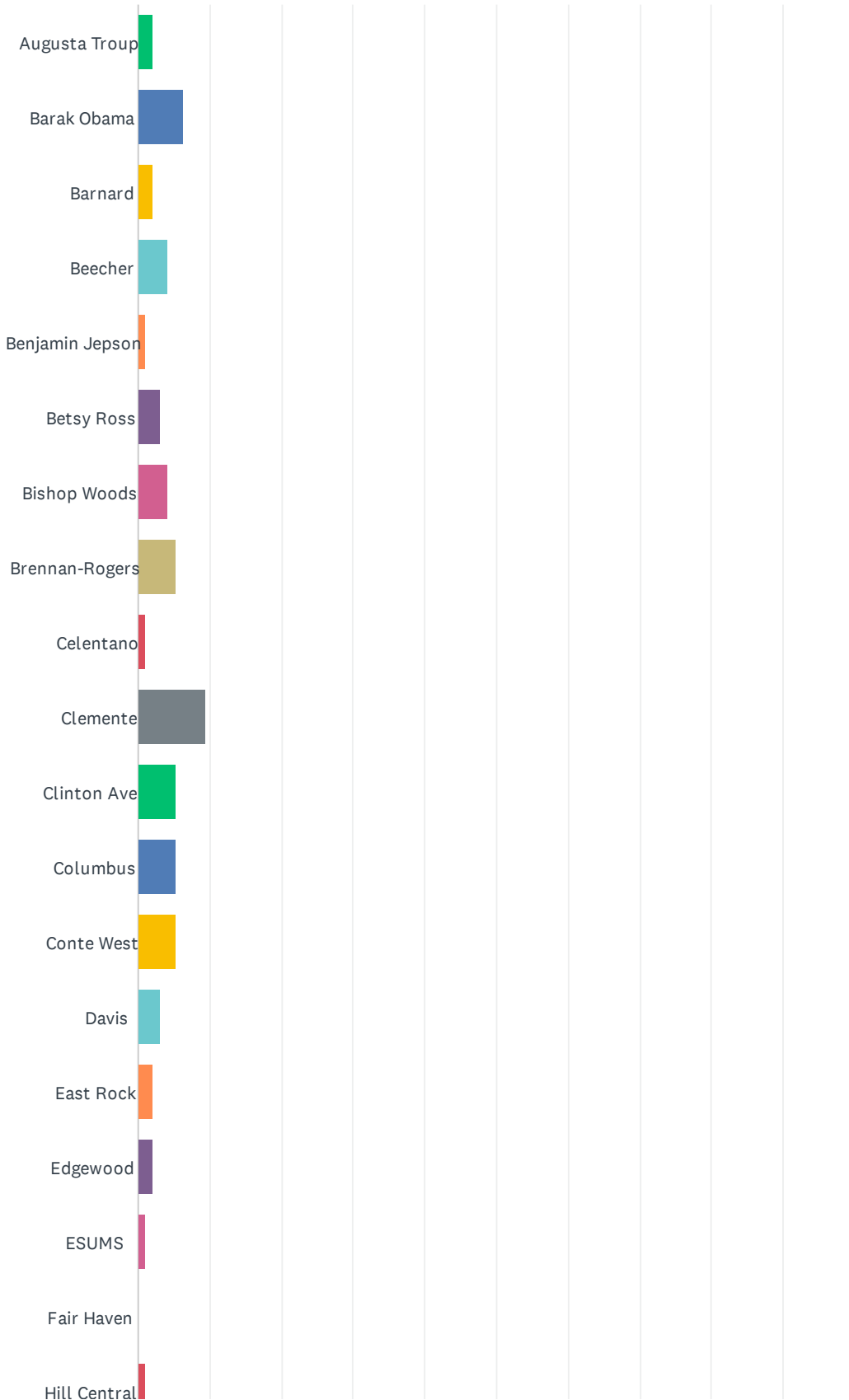
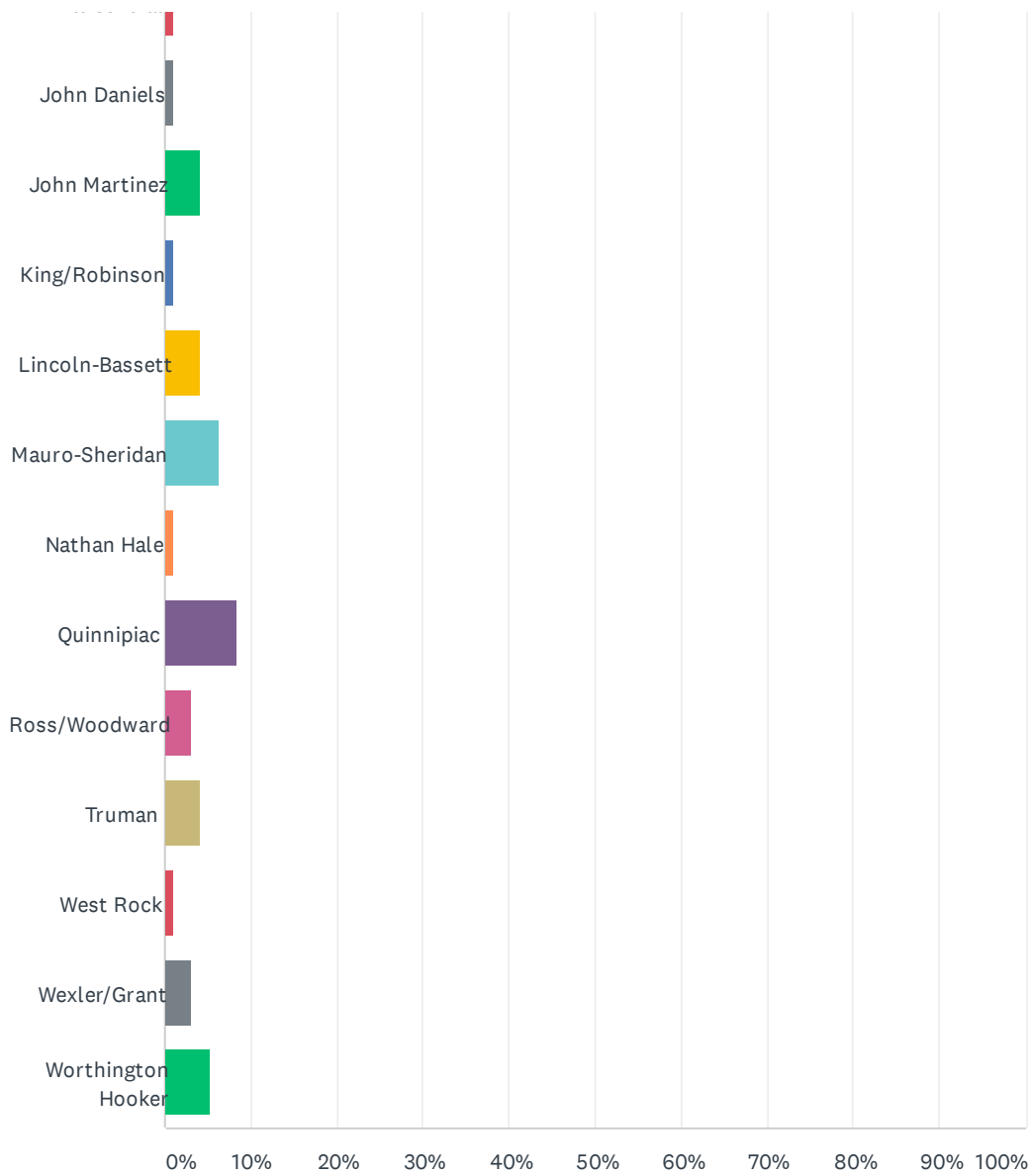

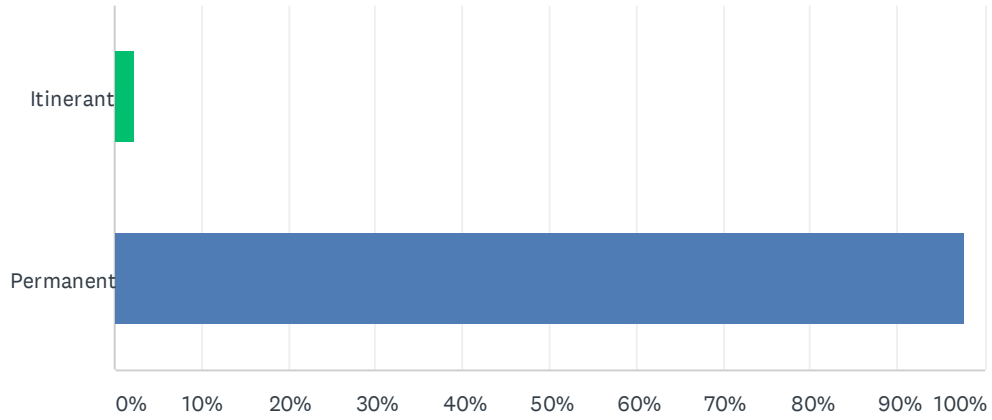

## Q2 Are you an itinerant or a permanent teacher?

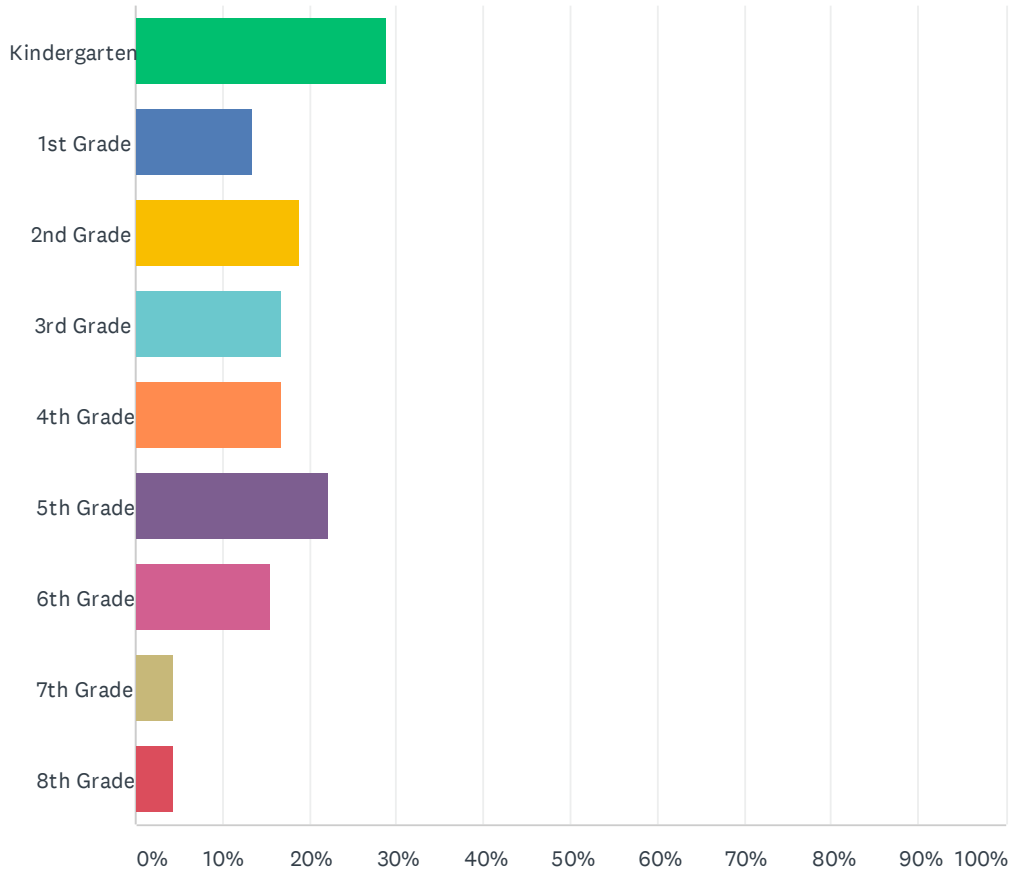

### Q3 What grades are you teaching? (select all that apply)

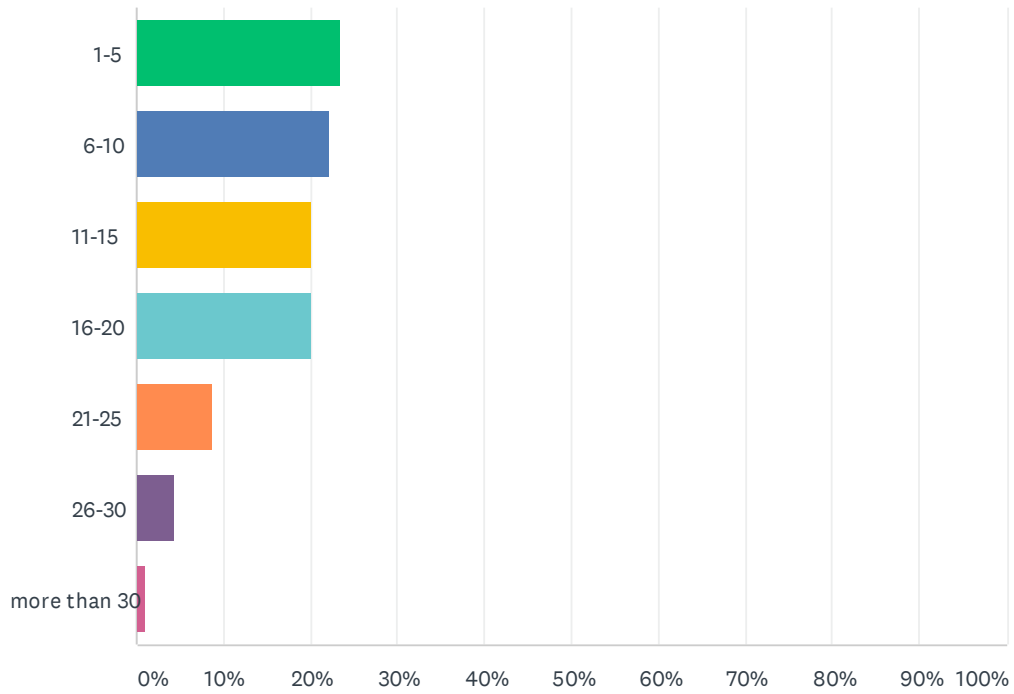

## Q4 How long have you been working as a teacher?

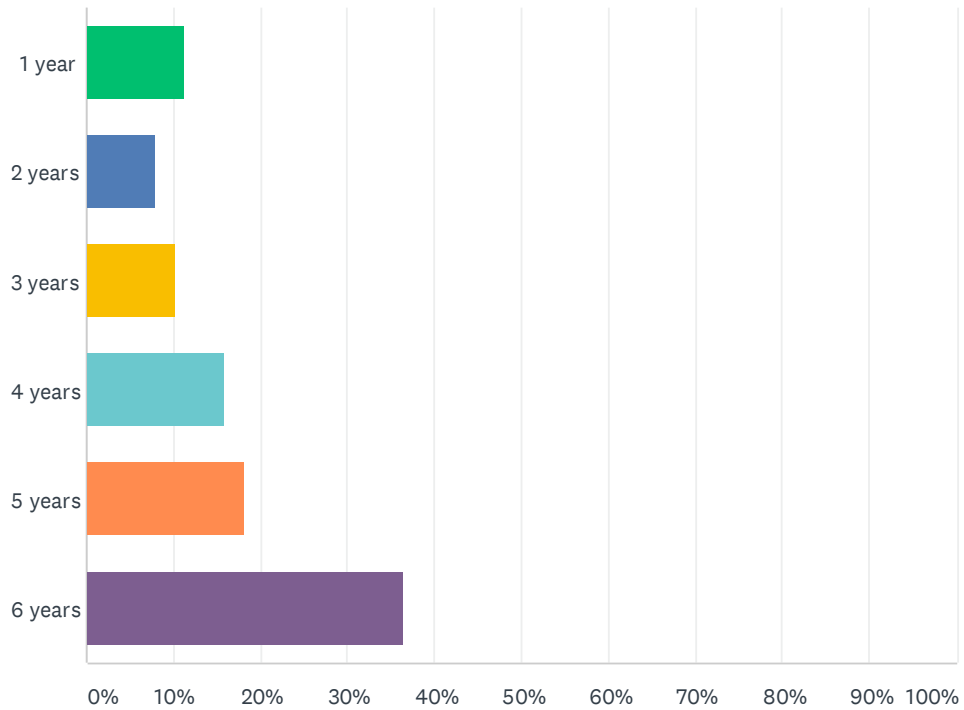

## Q5 How long have you been teaching the Michigan Model curriculum?

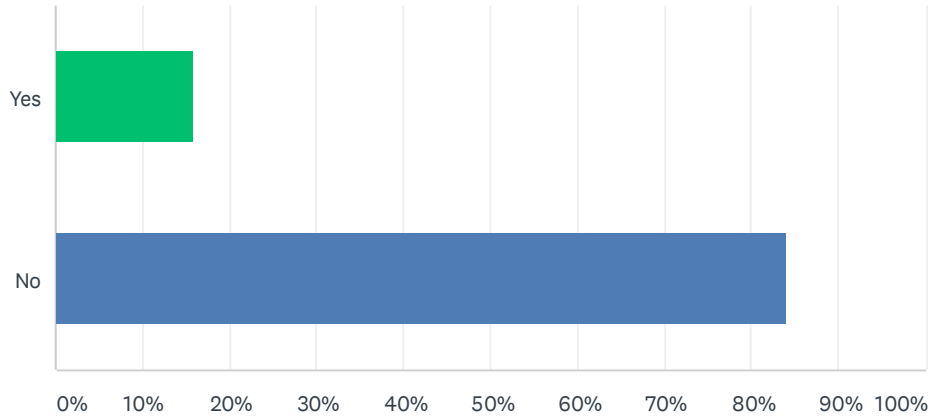

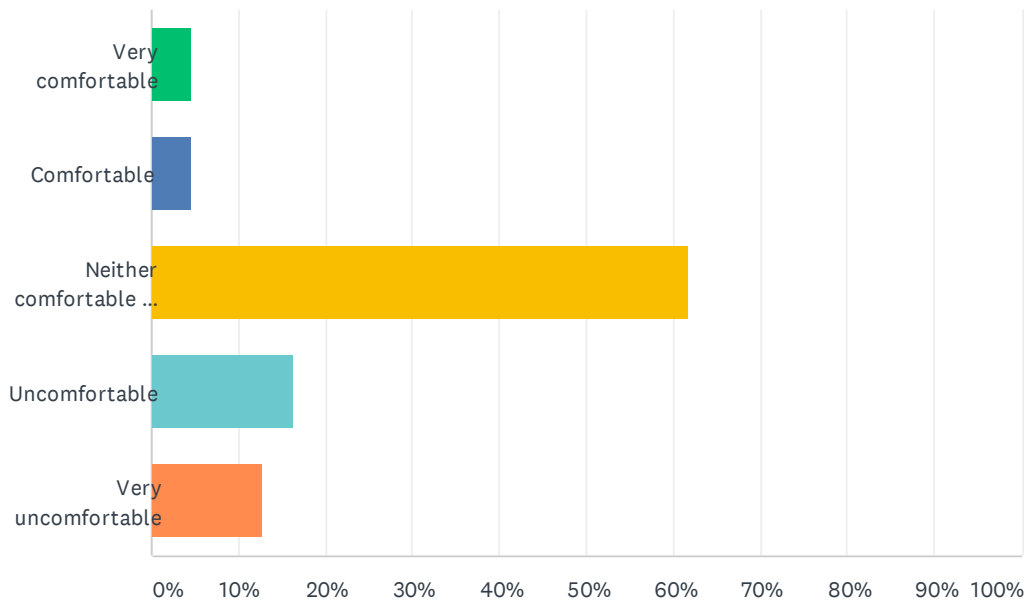

## Q7 If you taught puberty lessons, how comfortable were you doing that?

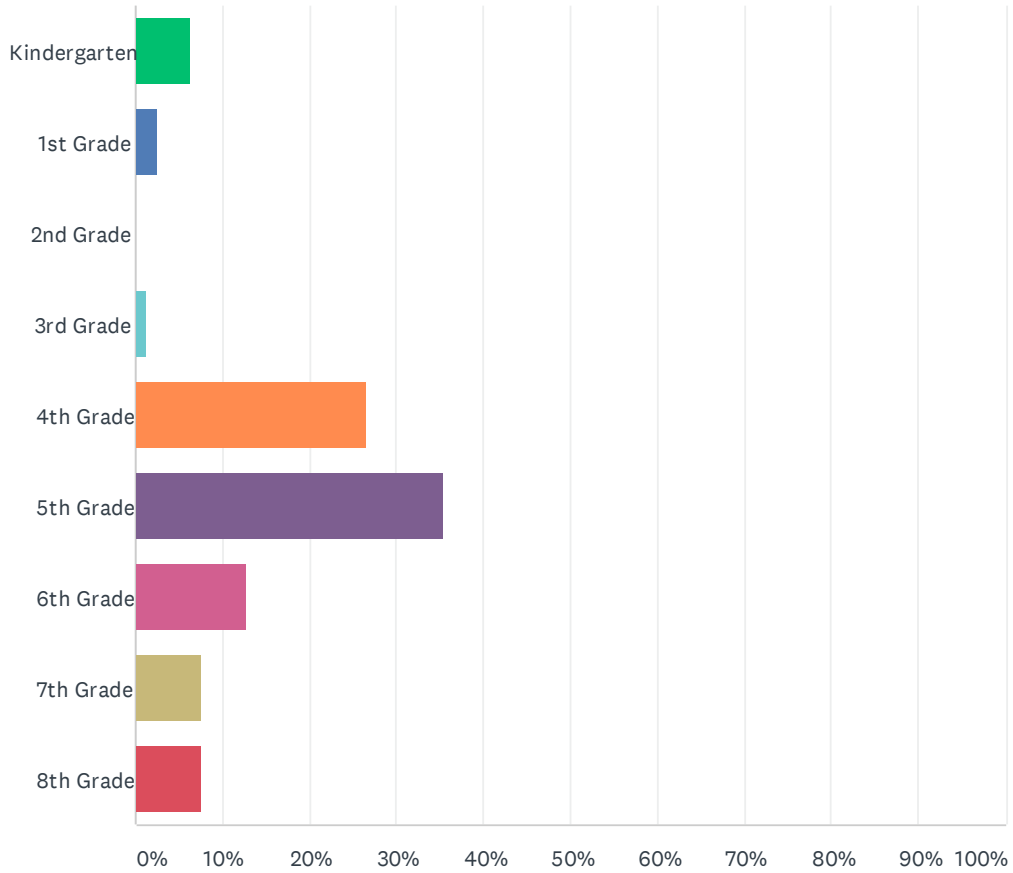

## Q8 At what grade are you introducing puberty lessons?

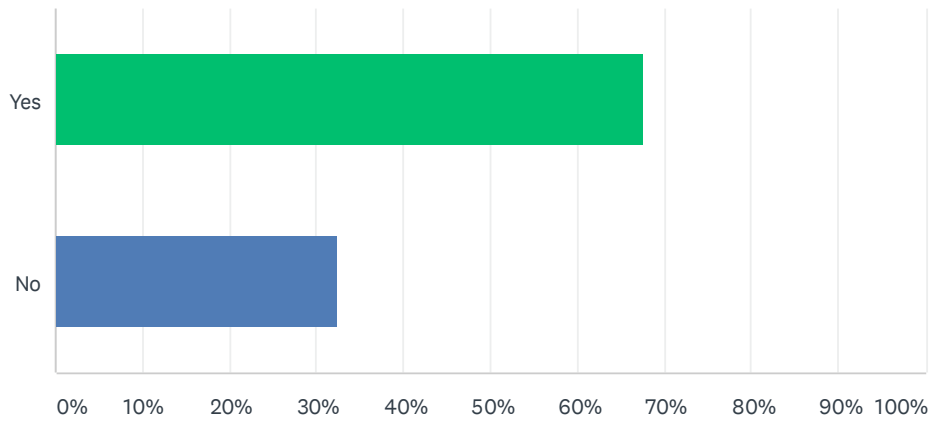

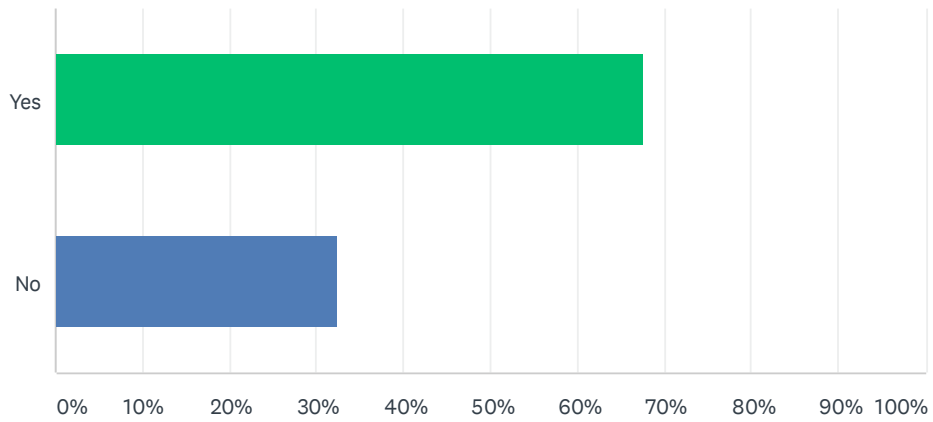

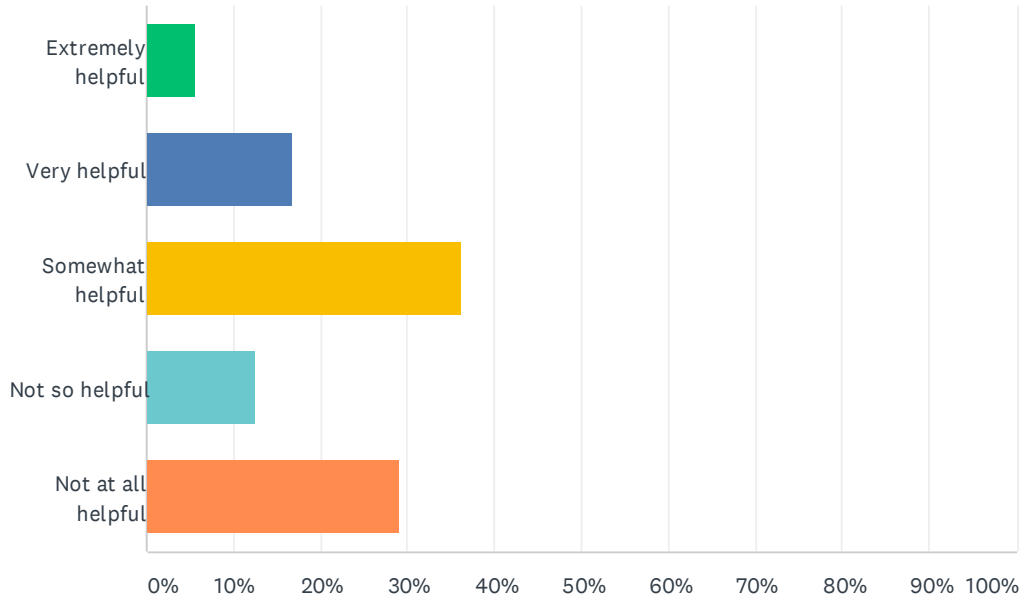

## Q17 If you received feedback, how helpful was it?

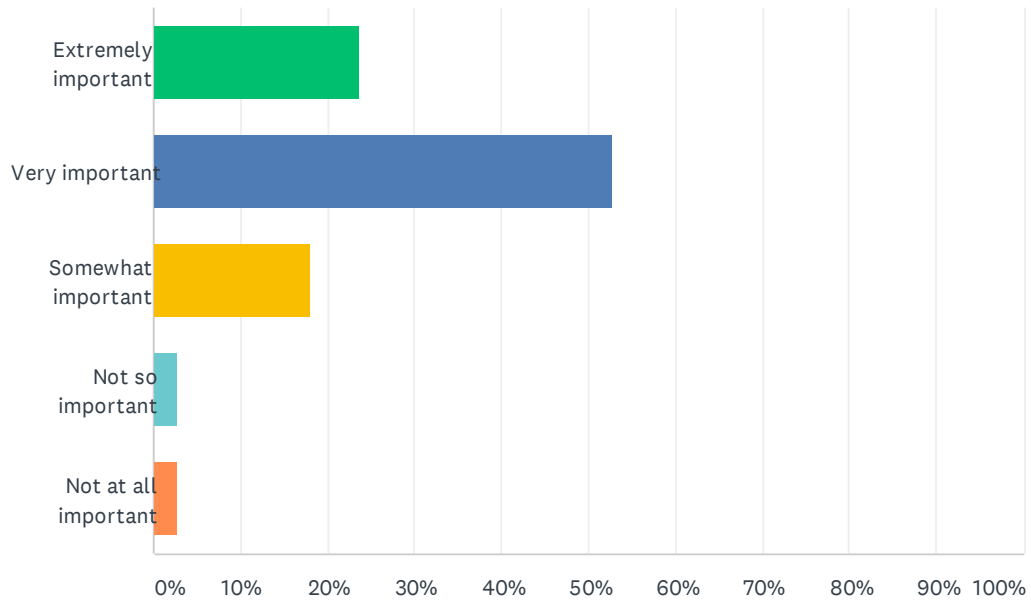

## Q18 How important is to have feedback about your teaching?

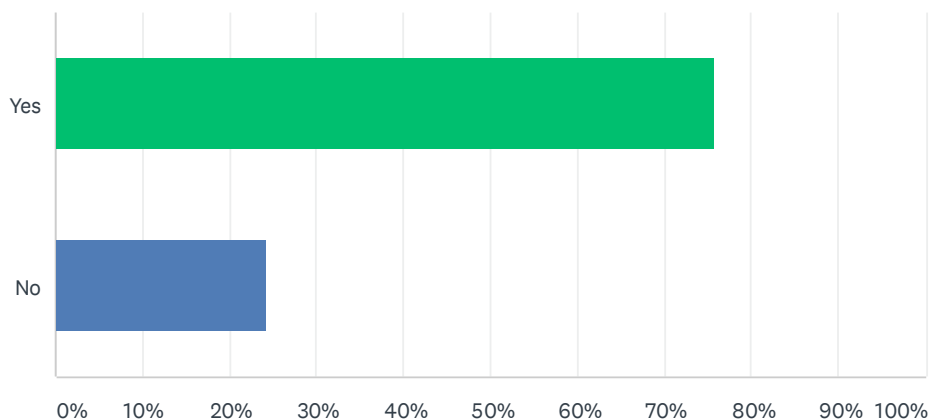

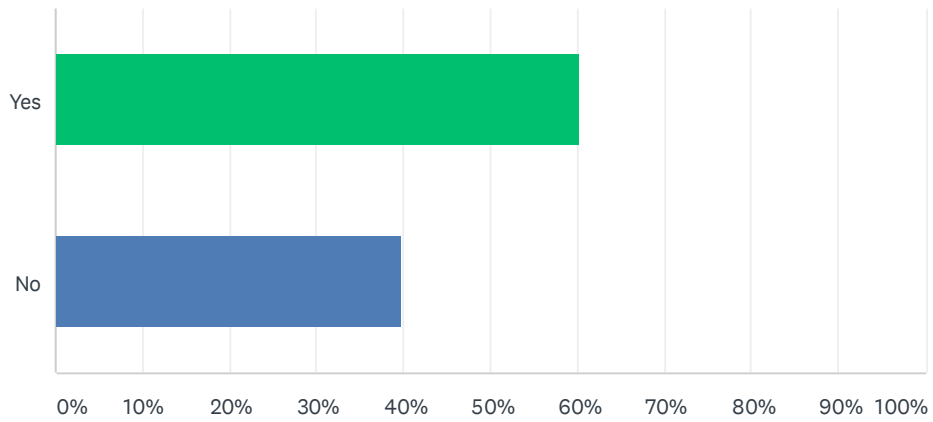
