	The bonus plan is geared towards attraction and retention of new teachers, paraprofessionals, special education professionals, school psychologists, social workers, etc. Social workers and elementary teachers who are "high vacancy" hires will receive an additional \$2,500 signing bonus, while paraprofessionals will receive \$1,250 each. Art, dance and history teachers will receive signing bonus of \$1,000 each minimum. Bonuses will be given at the end of the academic school year. The signing bonus duration will last until January 31, 2023.
