The ESH Coordinator oversees the enrollment process and makes recommendations for improvements at overall ESH sites as well as ensures the compliance of budgets and programming. The ESH Coordinator assumes responsibility for grant oversight; budget management; and coordination with schools and various city-wide private and governmental entities/officials. The ESH Coordinator monitors and aligns implementation of system-wide enactment of federal, state, and local early childhood mandates and requirements while working in conjunction with other NHPS offices to support student achievement.

2 part time certified summer staff to support various sites and ensure compliance.

10 PT Teachers to support extended school programs during summer.

This state grant provides funds for academic, enrichment, and recreational programs. Activities can take place before or after school, on weekends, and during school vacations

During the previous year, ESH funds were used to provide arts, science and music enrichment to over 1,200 NHPS students in some of our high needs schools. In addition to these activities, students had opportunities to engage in hands-on activities which supported and stimulated learning. Students in grades 9 -12 were able to obtain credits towards graduation by completing the summer program offerings at James Hillhouse H.S.

This grant addresses school reform goals by providing students with increased access to enriching activities and academic support. The ESH grant is used to leverage other NHPS grants and ensure a continuity of programming throughout the NHPS district. School reform is a community wide effort inclusive of parents, teachers, and businesses, non-profit organizations, local colleges, universities and the philanthropic community. The CT. Department of Education promotes the Whole School, Whole Community, Whole Child (WSCC) model which provides the infrastructure schools can use to engage students, families, staff, and the community-at-large to improve the cognitive, physical, social, and emotional development of every child, and supports the child in reaching their full potential
