Pursuant to the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), the Asbestos-Containing Materials in Schools rule requires local education agencies to inspect their school buildings for asbestos-containing building material, prepare asbestos management plans and perform asbestos response actions to prevent or reduce asbestos hazards. Public school districts and non-profit private schools, including charter schools and schools affiliated with religious institutions (collectively called local education agencies) are subject to the rule's requirements.

## Vendor "Right to Know" Acknowledgement Log

It is required to notify all occupants of a building that contains asbestos-containing materials, about the status of the material annually.

Is it important that all this information guides day-to-day maintenance and operations. For example, if there is asbestos in a building's floor tiles, staff must know not to use the buffer/sander to clean the area or else hazardous fibers could be released into the air.

In the event an outside contractor/vendor enters the premises, they must sign an acknowledgement log that should be prepared in a 3-ring binder, utilizing the attached document which should be available in the main office or Security Desk of the school.
