

Dear Parents and Staff,

This notification is required by the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act and is in accordance with 40CRF Part 763 of the Act. Every year, we are required to inform you that an Asbestos Management Plan (AMP) has been prepared and is available at Sound School, 60 South Water St, New Haven. The AMP includes an Operations and Maintenance (O&M) program designed to prevent asbestos fiber release through proper cleaning, maintenance and repair. The O&M program will remain in effect until all asbestos-containing building material (ACBM) is removed from the building.


The Thomas Building is inspected every six (6) months to determine any changes in the conditions of the materials. In addition, the building is thoroughly re-inspected every three (3) years by licensed Asbestos inspectors following the same basic criteria as the original inspection. Our next full inspection is set to be completed by in January 2021.

Sound School maintains its complete updated copy of the Asbestos Management Plan in the Principals Office. It is available during normal business hours for inspection.
