@Ives; Wednesday, April 6; 4:00-5:00

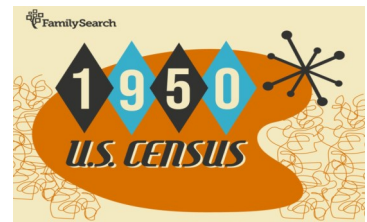
Join us once a month for an informal writer's workshop for teens to receive non-judgmental feedback on their writing and get to know other writers.
