# WHAT TO SUBMIT WITH YOUR APPLICATION

<u>AGE</u>: Child's birth certificate, legal custody or guardianship papers (if applicable). *Parents of 3 and 4 year olds are encouraged to apply.* 

ADDRESS: Current Utility Bill in your name (Gas, Electric, Phone or Cable bill).

<u>INCOME</u>: Proof of income (provide only what is applicable): Current and consecutive four weekly or two bi-weekly pay stubs for parents/guardians, W-2, or 1040; budget statement from the State Department of Social Services, Social Security office, Child Enforcement Bureau; notarized statement indicating parent/guardian(s) is not employed. (Additional paperwork may be requested to consider your eligibility for the program).

<u>MEDICAL</u>: A recent physical- State of Connecticut Department of Education Early Childhood Health Assessment Record (for children ages birth-5). Proof of a 2 year old or greater anemia and lead level test results, a TB assessment, immunizations records to include seasonal flu vaccination, and a health insurance card (Physical must have been within one year to date).

**DENTAL:** Recent Dental Exam (within the last 6 months).

All programs promote the enrollment of children with special needs.
