Dear Parent/Guardian,

Connecticut state law mandates that all students NEW to the district, students entering grades K, 7 & 10 must have an updated **physical examination** & up-to-date **required immunizations** in order to attend school. This goes for non-compliant 1<sup>st</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> grade students as well.

**Your child WILL BE EXCLUDED on**

**Monday, OCTOBER 4, 2021**

**\*\*DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL w/o documents\*\***

**We will not allow him/her into class.**

**\*\*YOU WILL BE CALLED TO PICK YOUR CHILD UP\*\***

If your child has not had a physical, please make an appointment with your child's provider to have this completed **as soon as possible**. Your child may be permitted into class if an appointment has been made and an appt. card or Dr's note is submitted verifying appointment date and time.
