New Haven Promise builds a culture in the public schools in which students aspire to attend and graduate from college; provides scholarship and support for those students; and facilitates their return to live, work and serve in the greater New Haven community.

Our scholarships are **EARNED BENEFITS** for New Haven residents. Students **MUST APPLY** during their high school senior year between Oct 1 and Dec 23 at app.newhavenpromise.org. (See benefits on the back of this card.)

Requirements to earn Promise:

- Must be a New Haven resident AND attend New Haven public or charter schools CONTINUOUSLY from the being of 9th grade through 12th grade graduation.
- Have a cumulative 3.0 weighted GPA or higher upon high school graduation (2.5-2.99 GPA for Passport to Promise applicants)
- Miss no more than 72 days in high school (includes excused and unexcused)
- Complete 40 Promise-approved community service hours and log them on Servo.city portal by April 1 of the senior year.
- Maintain a positive disciplinary record and earn a high school diploma
