- Maintain good attendance
- Get involved in the community
- Explore high schools, colleges and careers.
- Declare your commitment to earning Promise by completing the Pledge in middle school

9-12:

- Stay living in New Haven and attending New Haven public schools.
- Earn a 3.0+ GPA, which is a B average
- Keep good attendance and behavior. (Miss no more than 72 days of high school)
- Complete 40 hours of Promise approved community service.
- Complete your New Haven Promise application starting October 1st of your senior year
