- Facilities-
 - The Fair Haven staff and families received communication regarding the isolated bed bug incident.

- Staffing-
- Three FT Teaching Assistant positions remain open.
 - Meetings have been held with Superintendent and unions regarding grant funding, under enrollment, and structural changes.
 - Meetings are scheduled with HR regarding new job titles, posting, and noticing to staff of any changes.
 - Staff who are displaced will be offered open jobs.
 - We understand staff have concerns however we cannot address staffing questions with definitive answers until the grant award is received.
