<u>Purpose:</u> The New Haven Public Schools Security Department seeks to hire a vendor to work on-call security systems maintenance, inspection and repair services under the proposed specifications for the districts Security division.

Scope of Services

The Security Department will require at a minimum the following:

- a. The work to be performed by the Testing, Inspection, Preventive Maintenance, On-Call Repairs and Services by the Security Camera Systems Contractor under these Specifications shall consist of furnishing all material, labor, supervision, tools, supplies and other expenses necessary to provide repairs, maintenance, replacement services directed by the Board of Education Facilities for all types of security systems and devices in the New Haven Public School Buildings included but not limited to: servicing cameras, key pads, key cards, card access panels, electronic access doors, motion sensors, door contacts and other devices for both wired and wireless systems.
- b. The Contractor to provide reports or inspections if so requested by the City of New Haven and the Board of Education. All inspection reports are to be delivered to the Facilities Director and Chief of Security (both a hard copy and electronic copy). Email address to be provided after award.
- c. Contractor to maintain certification and necessary licenses for both Milestone and S2 software platforms.
- d. Provide lead time on ordered equipment and materials as requested by the NHPS Executive Director of Facilities, Director of Project Management, and Chief Operating Officer.
- e. The Vendor to provide reports if so requested by the City of New Haven and the Board of Education. All inspection reports are to be delivered to the Chief of Security and Chief Operating Officer (both a hard copy and electronic copy). Email address to be provided after award.
